

# What Federation Does

- Provides funding for a program for disadvantaged youth in our Partnership2Gether community of Kiryat Motzkin, Israel.
- Provides funding for our Community Rabbi offered through our partnership with Jewish Family Services of Greater Orlando.
- Provides funding for the Jewish Academy of Orlando to ensure they are able to provide formal Jewish Education for our children in grades K-5.
- Provides funding for teacher education and Jewish teen formal education through our Jewish Teen Education Network (JTEN) program.
- Provides scholarships for youth to go on Israel experiences through the Ronald Colman Israel Travel Scholarship program.
- Provides funding to send 20 women per year to Israel with the JWRP/Momentum program for an immersive Israel experience.
- Empowers adults with special needs through the RAISE (Recognizing Abilities & Inclusion of Special Employees) program by providing work and social-skills training.
- Cardozo Legal Society and Maimonides Medical Society affinity groups for Jewish legal and medical professionals.
- The Jerome J. Bornstein Leadership Development Program, providing Jewish leadership training for our future community leaders.
- Women's Division, a department of the Jewish Federation designed to provide Jewish women with the opportunity to create programs that are meaningful to them. Women's Division provides for an opportunity for Jewish women to gather and build friendships and relationships.
- Family Engagement programs including PJ Library and PJ Our Way, serving over 900 different families each year.
- Federation is 1/3 owner of TOP, the Jewish Foundation for Tampa, Orlando, and Pinellas County. TOP has \$54 million dollars under management and invested over \$6 million dollars in philanthropy to these three communities during the 2018-19 fiscal year.
- Provides funding for The Tribe, a partnership between The Roth Family JCC, Central Florida Hillel, and The Rosen JCC to provide programming for Jews in their 20s and 30s.
- Provides security resources to Jewish organizations, agencies, and synagogues, including offering services such as security assessments, grant request assistance, policy and procedure review, and serving as a liaison with local, state and federal law enforcement.
- Advocates on behalf of the Central Florida Jewish community.
- Manages the Jewish Community Campus in Maitland.

# What Federation Will Be Doing ...

- Providing funding for the Melton School of Adult Jewish Education, beginning in November 2019 to be in Central Florida. Classes will be offered at both The Roth Family JCC and The Rosen JCC.
- Creating new affinity groups to ensure every person in the Jewish community has an opportunity to create Jewish connections and relationships.
- Coordinating a no-solicitation Community Trip to Israel in April 2020.
- Setting a percentage of the annual unrestricted campaign that will support Israel through the Jewish Agency for Israel (JAFI) and The Joint Distribution Committee (JDC).
- Making a larger investment in family programming through expansion of our current program offerings to other parts of Central Florida while expanding and growing the number of children and families receiving the PJ Library books.
- Providing collaborate grants for Jewish agencies, synagogues, and organizations to create programs to impact the community.
- Undertaking a comprehensive Community Study of Jewish Central Florida, providing our Jewish agencies, synagogues, and organizations with the data they need to better provide for the needs of the community.
- Changing the PJ Library program from “one book per family” to “one book per child.” This will increase our reach to over 1,200 Jewish children in Central Florida each year.
