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The Jewish Federation of Greater Orlando (JFGO)

The JFGO Maitland Jewish Campus serves the Orlando area through its campus partners; The Roth Family Jewish Community Center (Fitness, Child/Youth Educational School services, hosts numerous community events and summer programs); Jewish Academy of Orlando (educating K-5 students, hosting religious services and various school related programming); Holocaust Memorial Resource and Educational Center (maintains Jewish Holocaust historical antiquities, educational-informative interactive displays, lectures, educational forums and hosts guest speaking engagements).

Facility Mission

To support Jewish life in Central Florida through the provision of programming and financial support of Jewish organizations that educate, advocate and connect Jewish community.

Background

This project is an acknowledgement of vulnerabilities that exist for comprehensive 2-way radio emergency communications. The project seeks to enhance the rapid emergency notification of all campus staff/personnel of a building-emergent threat, existing medical emergency or impending extreme weather alert. This project is targeted to mitigate the identified vulnerability of limited mass emergency notification to reduce vulnerabilities to the previously described events. This project is subsidized through the FEMA FY2021 **Non-Profit Security Grant Program (NSGP-UA)**. This funding and expenditure is **time restrictive** for award of contract, acquisition of material/equipment, labor type and completion to functioning system.

Solicitation

This solicitation is a request for proposal for the delivery, installation, programming of (89) Motorola SL300 handheld 2-way digital radios, additional radio battery and charging cradle. The installation process must include integration to onsite analog/digital repeater. Programming must include (5) channels. Channel 1 Emergency-Security Broadcast Channel, Channel 2 Maintenance primary operation channel with scan ability of Channel 1, Channel 3 ECLC primary operation channel with scan ability of Channel 1, Channel 4 JAO primary operation channel with scan ability of Channel 1, and Channel 5 Youth primary operation channel with scan ability of Channel 1. (Radios and Repeater channel/s must be programmed to existing FCC Licensed Frequencies). All systems will be tested for comprehensive broadcast coverage over entire campus grounds/facilities.

Objectives

To complete the on-going campus-wide application of facility structure hardening and emergency readiness; to thwart active-threat impacts through emergency early warning systems as well as provide immediate notification of emergency life-threatening medical situations where rapid trained response is critical and time-sensitive.

Scope of Design and Labor

There is a preference to acquire the Motorola SL300 due to its size, shape, portability, channel-scan capability, digital and price point relative to capability. There is a requirement to meet latest industry standards previously listed in the solicitation narrative regarding FCC compliance. All equipment, materials and workmanship must be warranted and serviceable by the installing subcontractor or certified service agent for the manufacturer. Proper installation is critical to the effectiveness of these systems; therefore installation must meet previously listed standards and be warranted as well.

- Proposed timeline for FCC frequency registration, equipment installation, testing and staff training

 - Project Quote must include listed equipment, programming of radios and repeater set to digital channels.
- Subcontractor Requirements
 - Motorola Commercial Radio Authorized Reseller of 2-Way Handheld Radios/Equipment/Factory Warranty
 - Be registered in SAM.gov (System for Award Management) – Federal approved Contractor
 - Must Certify that the prospective subcontractor is free from; Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion or Disqualification from participation in this transaction by an Federal Dept. or Agency
 - Must Certify to the best of their knowledge that they are not participating in any form of Lobbying for Contracts, Grants, Loans, and Cooperative Agreements.
 - Understand that the Sub-Recipient of the grant has sole right to award a contract to a responsible firm whose proposal is most advantageous to the program, with price and other factors considered. Additionally JFGO reserves the right to award a contract to an offeror other than the lowest priced offeror.
